I think everyone, at least once in their lives, have to live such an experience.



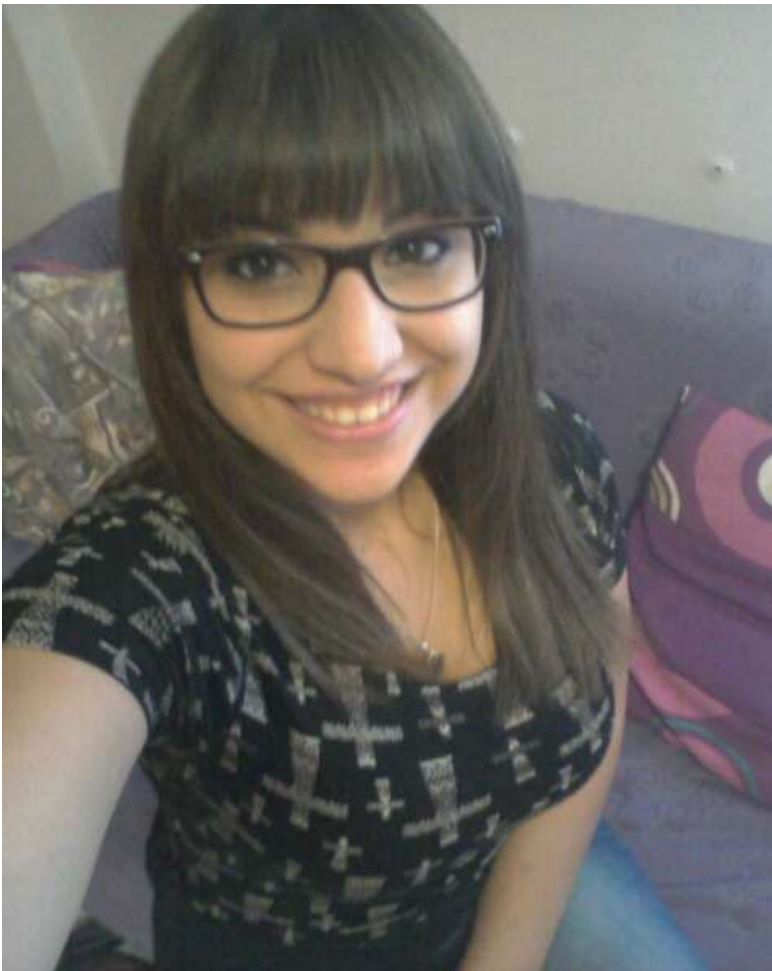
DESIRÉE CARUSO
